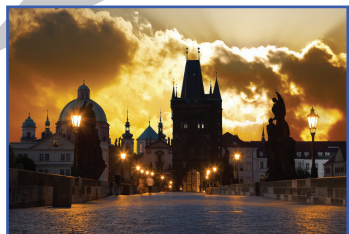
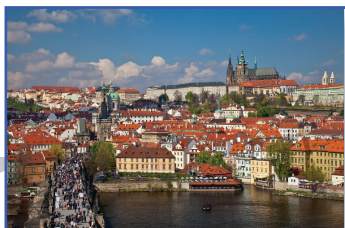


## Conference Venue

Authors are encouraged to submit abstracts (150–200 words) for BESTInfra 2017 until 30th November 2016 the latest. The abstract should clearly state the aims, content and main conclusions of the paper.
